This document is intended to meet state Private Sector Re-Entry Program requirements where they exist, in accordance with ESF-18 and applicable state laws.

The holder of this document/message is tasked with transporting critical goods, or providing <u>essential services</u> in order to support the continued operation or reopening of Costco Wholesale or Costco Logistics locations as soon as possible. Costco warehouses sell critical commodities such as fuel, pharmacy items, food, water and hard goods. This letter serves as documentation of the need to enter and occupy Costco facilities, and serves as a request to law enforcement to exempt the holder from curfew requirements. Costco locations routinely operate from 4 a.m. to 11 p.m., but travel and other business needs may require that pass-holders travel at all times of the day.

Provide the following documents in addition to this letter:

- 1. Valid government ID (e.g. driver's license or passport)
- 2. Proof of employment (e.g. Costco name badge, work order, delivery paperwork)
